## **Object Descriptor Element**

An object element defines a well-known object in the IceGrid registry. Clients can refer to this object using only its identity, or they can search for well-known objects of a specific type.

This element may only appear as a child of an adapter element or a replica-group element.

The following attributes are supported:

Attribute	Description	Required
identity	Specifies the identity by which this object is known.	Yes
property	Specifies the name of a property to generate that contains the stringified identity of the object. This attribute is only allowed if this object element is a child of an adapter element.	No
type	An arbitrary string used to group objects. By convention, the string represents the most-derived Slice type ID of the object, but an application is free to use another convention.	No
proxy- options	The proxy options to use for the proxy of the well-known object return by IceGrid.	No
