

C++ Mapping for Enumerations

A Slice [enumeration](#) maps to the corresponding enumeration in C++. For example:

Slice
<pre>enum Fruit { Apple, Pear, Orange };</pre>

Not surprisingly, the generated C++ definition is identical:

C++
<pre>enum Fruit { Apple, Pear, Orange };</pre>
