Operation Index

[print](#) — Print a message.

[trace](#) — Log a trace message.

[warning](#) — Log a warning message.

[error](#) — Log an error message.

[cloneWithPrefix](#) — Returns a clone of the logger with a new prefix.

Operations

void print(string message)

Print a message. The message is printed literally, without any decorations such as executable name or time stamp.

void trace(string category, string message)

Log a trace message.

Parameters

[category](#) — The trace category.

[message](#) — The trace message to log.

void warning(string message)

Log a warning message.

Parameters

[message](#) — The warning message to log.
