

Objective-C Mapping for Enumerations

A Slice [enumeration](#) maps to the corresponding enumeration in Objective-C. For example:

Slice

```
["objc:prefix:EX"]
module Example {
    enum Fruit { Apple, Pear, Orange };
};
```

The generated Objective-C definition is:

Objective-C

```
typedef enum {
    EXApple, EXPear, EXOrange
} EXFruit;
```
