

Variable Descriptor Element

A variable element defines a [variable](#).

This element may only appear as a child of an [application](#) element or [node](#) element.

The following attributes are supported:

Attribute	Description	Required
name	Specifies the variable name. The value of this variable is substituted whenever its name is used in variable syntax, as in <code>\${name}</code> .	Yes
value	Specifies the variable value. If not defined, the default value is an empty string.	No

Here is an example to demonstrate the use of this element:

<pre> <icegrid> <application name="SampleApp"> <variable name="Var1" value="foo"/> <variable name="Var2" value="\${Var1}bar"/> ... </application> </icegrid> </pre>
